## 2. CPAC Update, presented by MARCY

- Theatre floor painted touch up with paint from Ace Hardware, BEN INT Flat Black. We should plan on touching up after Earnest strike if needed.
- Will need to begin purchasing some mics, to include mics for darker skin colors Steve estimates \$300/piece, and CPAC would go 50/50 with Shoestring. We discussed reassessing our mic needs after Earnest, and will ask Steve for recommendations.
- Scheduling: It is very important that Chris receives rehearsal schedules and any updates along the way, even if a rehearsal is moved or cancelled that same day, so that he can update the calendar with the county. We decided that it would be the responsibility of the director to provide the initial rehearsal schedule to Chris, and the stage manager's job to report changes to Chris.
- The county would prefer that all flats be stored in the upright storage area and not against the walls. To accommodate this, we may need to build or buy more racks.

- There have been increasing reports of asylum seekers in the area of CPAC. Please ensure that all doors are locked when leaving the property, and be careful about propping doors open.
- Trash cans since the facility isn't used daily, any food garbage should be disposed of directly into the dumpster or carried out. There have been increased pests/rodents seen in the facility
