Picasso: Rights for I'm Herbert, the Reader's production, have been secured. REGINA plans to cast a different couple for each show. MIKE and DON will submit a budget in January. Audition notices will be included in the January newsletter, but also sent out again 2 weeks before the auditions.

Summer workshops: We need to schedule the February show selection workshop and invite directors.

Old Business:

RAY took care of purchasing materials for the stage manager kit, including a hot glue gun that can be used by all departments. He also purchased a storage shed and tools.

We agreed that the digital media manager and graphic designer will be paid \$150/show, plus a \$150 bonus.

The Winterfest parade was a hit, with participants from Readers, Kids, and the mainstage group. Many thanks to CLAIRE and Gabe and Ryan for designing and driving the float.

We are still discussing the best way to display our show posters, including swapping them out, putting digital posters on a lobby TV and/or the website, and using permanent cases for the posters.
